

Game Sheet Scorer

You have been supplied with an inventory of RI State League Game Sheets. There is also a supply of these game sheets in the communication box in the MSC foyer. All State games must be scored on these game sheets.

For home games at MSC, the game sheet scorer must sit in the Mount press box. The scorer must complete the home roster (affix the labels) on the sheet as well as locating the visiting team representative/coach prior to the start of the game for them to complete their portion of the score sheet. It is also important that the coaches on both teams 'scratch' out the name of any players that are not at the game. The game sheet scorer should also make note that every player/player number on both teams is present to confirm scratches when in the Mount Press box.

IMPORTANT: For state league games it is imperative that "STATE LEAGUE" is written in the upper right hand corner of the game sheet.

When scoring a HOME game, you must record:

1). The number of the player that scored goals for both teams. The referee will give this number to the press box immediately after the goal is scored. If the referee does not provide this information, the timekeeper must 'buzz' the horn to notify the referee.

2). The number(s) of the player(s) that assisted the goal. If the referee provides only one assist to a goal, the scorekeeper cannot 'give' another assist. Also, if you do not agree with the referee you cannot change his decision. You must record 'ONLY' the numbers that are given by the referee.

3). The 'time' the goal was scored.

4). The player's number, infraction and time of each penalty for each team in the game. During the game it is the scorekeeper's responsibility to notify the referee and coach when a player has 3 penalties. If a player gets 4 penalties, he/she must sit the next State League game. When a player receives a penalty at

the end of a game and he/she cannot complete the penalty time, the referee may make a note at the bottom of the score sheet that this player must sit the first 5 minutes of the next State League game. You must tell the referee this information before the game starts so he/she will note this on the score sheet.

IMPORTANT: Please remind the coach to notify the President of any serious penalties, such as fighting or misconduct. A record of these penalties needs to be kept by the Executive Board.

5). The goalie's saves for each team. Saves are those pucks that are 'stopped' by the goalie but not the ones which the goalie just 'clears' to the side.

6). The referee's signature(s).

At AWAY games, it is the game sheet scorer's responsibility to complete the roster/provide labels on the home team's game sheet and obtain the WNS copy at the end of the game. Usually the game sheet is given to the coach, so please ensure that it is retrieved and placed in the team's state book. You also need these score sheets to update the player log in the coach's blue book after each game.

SPECIAL NOTE: Please remember that 'scratches' are important and need to be monitored.
